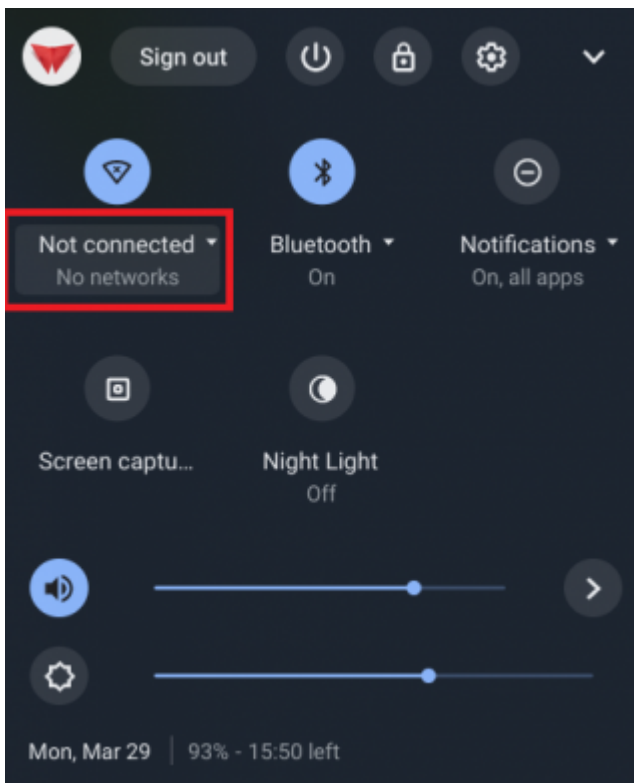


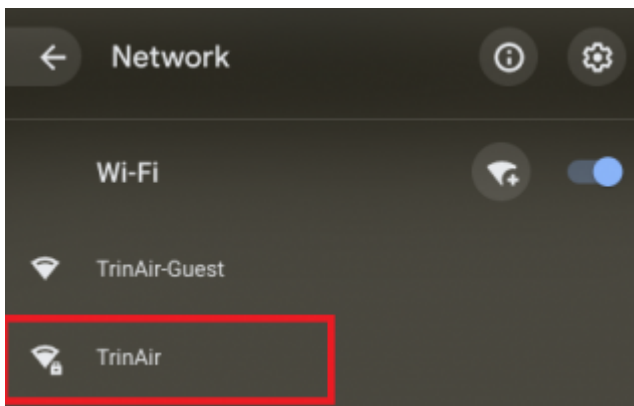
Connecting to Wi-fi on a Chromebook

Chromebooks require a few extra settings to connect to our campus wi-fi network, TrinAir. Follow the instructions below to connect your Chromebook:

1. Click on the status area in the bottom right of the screen, then click on the dropdown underneath the wi-fi network symbol (it will likely say "Not connected").



2. Click on TrinAir.



3. On the Join Wi-Fi network screen, set the settings as follows:

- EAP method - **PEAP**
- EAP Phase 2 authentication - **MSCHAPv2**
- Server CA certificate - **Do not check**
- Identity - **your Trinity username (do not include @trnty.edu)**
- Password - **your Trinity password**

4. After selecting the appropriate settings, click **Connect**.

NOTE: On some devices, it may be necessary to click Connect three or more times in a row if you receive an "Error configuring" message, especially if you have already attempted to connect to TrinAir without the above settings.
